A Quick 2021 Update

The year of 2021 continued to be a Covid struggle. We made around 550 masks for various companies and individuals. Delivering the Wellness Kits was straining and the cost of everything increased. In November three volunteers lost beloved family members and several members of our staff came down with the dreaded virus. Despite the illnesses and losses volunteers put in extra hours and completed 750 kits in 2021. December is always a hard-pressed month in the best of times. This year we made an additional 101 Wellness Kits for delivery to new teen moms with their babies and 45 were given to Eagle Pathway, who hosts a Christmas dinner for children at risk. We continue to ship to DCS (Dept. of Child Safety), nonprofits helping at risk kids across Arizona, and are hoping to reach our goal of 1000 Wellness Kits in 2022.again.

You can redirect \$500 if *filling single* and \$1000 if *married filling jointly*. (IF your tax liability is less than your contribution, the unused credit is available as a future Tax Credit for up to 5 years.)
